

## VAT Exemption Form

You will not have to pay VAT if you can declare that you are chronically sick or disabled. Chronically sick means that you have an illness that is likely to last a long time e.g. angina, arthritis etc.

Disabled means substantially or permanently handicapped by illness or injury. To claim VAT relief you do not have to be registered disabled, you must however state the nature of your disablement or illness where indicated on the form.

**Note:** If you are in any doubt as to whether you are eligible to receive goods or services Zero rated for VAT, you should seek advice from your local VAT office before signing this declaration.

**Warning:** Section 72(3) of the VAT Act 1994 provides for severe penalties for anyone who makes use of a document that they know to be false for the purpose of obtaining VAT relief.
